Summer House began in the summer of 1973 as a six-week pilot program to determine the success of group home living for adults with disabilities. The response to the project from both parents and residents was overwhelmingly favorable and a nonprofit corporation, Summer House Inc., was formed in 1974. We now support 12 residents in the Woodland home, 12 in the Davis home, and approximately 50 other adults in Woodland, Davis, Esparto, West Sacramento, and other parts of Yolo County through our independent living & Supported Living Services Programs.
